

iNEAC Symposium Meeting Travel Award

The interRAI Network of Excellence in Acute Care (iNEAC) conducts research and instrument development relevant to hospital (emergency and inpatient) and post-acute care of older people.

The Award

Up to \$3,000 USD for lowest cost airfare and symposium meeting accommodation, to attend the iNEAC Symposium Meeting in New Orleans, April 8th-10th, 2014.

Eligibility

Applicants must fulfill all of the following criteria:

1. You are a registered PhD or MD student at a recognized academic institution.
2. Your attendance is being nominated by an iNEAC or interRAI member (Fellow or Associate Fellow).
3. You are conducting research relevant to hospital (emergency and inpatient) and post-acute care of older people.
 - a. Either:
 - i. Using data derived from interRAI Instruments, or
 - ii. Developing new interRAI assessment systems or applications
4. You are prepared to present your interRAI related work at the iNEAC Symposium.
5. Your complete application is submitted before the deadline (**October 1st, 2013**).

How to Apply

To be eligible for funding, an application should include the following documents:

1. A completed **iNEAC Travel Award Application (see attached)**. Including:
 - a. Your Information
 - b. Research Abstract
 - c. Estimated Travel Costs
2. A **short letter** from the iNEAC or interRAI member (Fellow or Associate Fellow) that is nominating your attendance at the iNEAC Symposium. The letter must:
 - a. Confirm your status as a PhD or MD student at a recognized academic institution.
 - b. Provide a rationale for your attendance in relation to the strategic goals of iNEAC.
3. A copy of your **abbreviated curriculum vitae** (3 pages maximum);
